Year 1	<p style="text-align: center;">Greetings</p> <p>Children will learn that French is a language spoken in France and many other countries. The focus will be on listening and speaking skills and learning through simple songs. Year 3	<p style="text-align: center;">Moi et ma famille (Me and my family)</p> <p>Children will revise how to say their name and age and learn some family words to create their own little family album in French either real or imaginary!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Les animaux (Pets)</p> <p>Pupils will learn nouns for animals and how to create simple sentences using adjectives through the story of 'Tu as un animal?' (Do you have a pet?)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">La chenille qui fait des trous (The Hungry Caterpillar)</p> <p>This unit focuses on memory and performance in that it asks pupils to retell a familiar story - Pupils will learn or revise vocabulary from the story such as numbers, days of the week, fruits and other foods</p>
Year 4	<p style="text-align: center;">En Classe (In Class)</p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn about daily life in a school in France. They will learn to follow class instructions in French learn to count and recognise numbers to 31. Pupils will join in songs to revise the days and learn the months and will learn how to write dates in French.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Dans ma trousse (In my pencil case)</p> <p>In this unit pupils learn some nouns (pencil case items) and develop more awareness of gender. They revise the verb forms 'j'ai - I have' and encounter the negative form Je n'ai pas de... Pupils will also join in with a retelling of a French traditional tale 'Les Quatre Amis' (The Four Friends)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">A l'école (At school)</p> <p>We continue the theme of school and learn what a typical French timetable looks like. Pupils learn to give opinions on subjects they like or dislike, giving reasons.</p>
Year 5	<p style="text-align: center;">Ma Ville (My town)</p> <p>As part of our pen pal project pupils will learn to describe where they live and learn about the town of Tours in France.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Le temps (The weather)</p> <p>Pupils will learn weather phrases and learn to sing/ chant a weather rap. We will end the unit learning to describe the weather in French speaking countries around the world.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Les Vêtements (Clothes)</p> <p>Children will learn to describe what someone is wearing using clothes nouns and adjectives. We will end the unit with a fashion show.</p>
Year 6	<p style="text-align: center;">Ma Ville (My town)</p> <p>As part of our pen pal project pupils will learn to describe their town and learn about the town of Tours in France. They will learn the poem 'Dans Paris' and adapt it to create their own version 'Dans Liverpool'.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Décrire les gens (Describing people)</p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn to describe hair and eyes and revise clothes. We will play games like 'Guess Who?' and will finish the unit being able to describe some famous portraits.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Au Café (At the café)</p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn about café culture in France and popular foods. They will take part in café roleplays learning how to ask for food and drink items politely.</p>
