



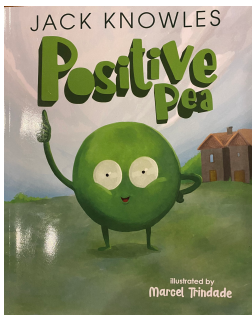

Child of Excellence



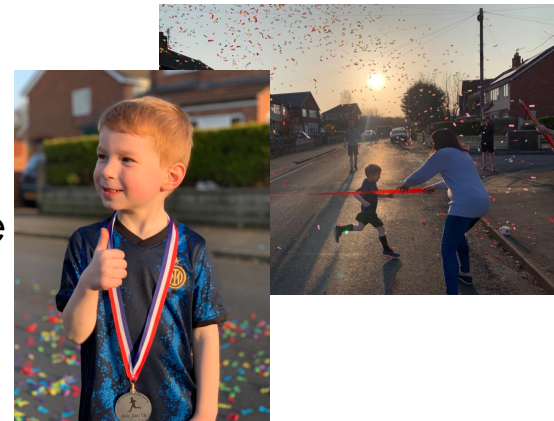
